Introduction

- Huge shifts in equality of both income and opportunity
- The longer people live in communities with fewer resources and opportunities, the worse their chances of achieving economic stability
- Privilege cannot be understood without the context of place
- Safe housing and neighborhoods, good schools, and opportunities for pro-social engagement are largely influenced by the community in which one is born, raised and resides
- For many, geography is destiny and this is especially true for children



Indicators of Communities in Distress

- Low high school graduation rate
- High housing vacancy rate
- High unemployment rate
- High poverty rate
- Low median income compared to state income
- Decrease in available jobs
- Decrease in neighborhood business establishments

Virginia Early Childhood Foundation Initiatives

- Smart Beginnings
 - Connects diverse partners, assets and efforts at community level
 - Benefits approximately 100 cities/counties
 - Tracks/documents indicators of increased school readiness
- Virginia Star Quality
 - Voluntary system to assess, improve and communicate level of quality in early care and education settings
 - Designed to help families identify and assist programs in providing high quality early care/education
 - Of the 5,424 eligible programs, 8% participated in 2014; target for 2016 is 15%



Centers for Disease Control Initiatives

Legacy for Children

- Program model developed by the CDC
- Core belief is that parents can have a significant effect on child development, regardless of socio-economic circumstances
- Evidence based study
 - Goals Improve child outcomes by promoting positive parenting among low-income mothers of infants and children
- Intervention program study conducted in Miami and Los Angeles focusing on education for mothers of kids born into poverty
- Followed children from birth to age 5
- Kids were evaluated on language, thinking ability, behavior, social skills and physical health




Race To The Top Early Learning Challenge

Harlem Children's Zone

- Non-profit founded in 1970 that designs, funds, and operates a holistic system of education, social services and community building programs in Harlem from birth to college

 - Help kids early in life and build a critical mass of adults that understand what it takes for children to succeed
